Snake Creek Canal Bridge (Bridge Number 900077) Full Road Closures

Three-Week Nighttime Closures Starts Sunday, September 8

Islamorada, Village of Islands, Fla. – Beginning Sunday, September 8, the bridge located over the Snake Creek Canal at Mile Marker (MM) 85 in Monroe County will be **closed Sunday through Thursday nights for up to three weeks**, while the contractor cleans and paints under the bridge deck, as part of the ongoing bridge rehabilitation project.

Closures are expected to last for four (4) hours between 11:45 p.m. and 4 a.m. During that time, drivers will be required to wait on either side of the bridge approach until notified by the police officers that traffic may resume. In the case of actual emergencies, operations will pause to allow emergency response vehicles to pass.

High mast vessel marine traffic will be able to cross the Snake Creek Channel at 10 p.m. and at 4 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
