Dear Members,

As we have said before the situation with Covid-19 is constantly changing.

We are still at a mandated 50% occupancy for indoor seating with proper social distancing. Outdoor seating is also available with appropriate social distancing.

We are allowing only those with a reservation to have a drink at the bar prior to going to their table so I could keep within the mandated guidelines of 50 % occupancy.

Monroe County has issued a directive requiring face coverings to be worn outside whenever social distancing of six feet or more is not possible. Also, all employees and customers must wear a face coverings in all public establishments, the face coverings may be removed when seated, but must be worn if you leave your seat.

I want to thank all of you for your cooperation and understanding as we navigate this very fluid environment.

Dear Members,

On Behalf of the Board of Directors I would like to bring you up to date on the State of the Club during these unusual times we are experiencing. There have been some great questions asked for Vinnie & myself to address.

The club is operating at 50% capacity as mandated by the county, which allows us to have 40 guests inside the club at any given time. This can be challenging, and making reservations as early as possible will help better facilitate your requests. If you wish to stay after dinner for a drink we encourage outside seating so that we can maintain our guest count at 40.

It is also important to keep in mind that bar seating/service is limited to those members who have a reservation for a table that evening. Table seating is also limited to stay with-in mandated guidelines of social distancing. Liquor service is only available to seated guests at the table or at the bar with a prior dinner reservation.

Thanks to the efforts of Vinnie & the Staff the club is financially stable and will make it through these difficult times. Our employees are healthy and appreciative of your continued support

We have re-opened for lunch Thursday, Friday & Saturday only, with normal operating hours (11:30-2:00 ) & Dinner hours are Tuesday—Saturday 5:30 to 8:00pm .Vinnie & the Chef have created a new summer dinner menu, as well as nightly specials.

We are continuing with our sanitation protocols, sanitizing all contact surfaces daily and intermittently through out the day and professionally fog sanitizing twice monthly. The three hand sanitizing dispensers have arrived and are located in each rest room and one in the main entrance of the club.



Dear Members,

I wanted to keep you informed on the protocols we are using at the club to keep all members and staff safe and healthy during these trying times we are all facing.

We are sanitizing all contact surfaces in the club daily and intermittently through the day including, Dining room chairs, doors & bathroom fixtures. None of the tables are preset, silverware is rolled in dinner napkins & Salt & pepper shakers are replaced with a sanitized set.

There are numerous other changes that you may notice, such as no sugar caddies or cracker baskets or mints in a bowl at the front door. If you would like a mint please ask Marguerite I'm sure she will get one for you.

There is hand sanitizer at the table near the host stand. All staff is wearing face coverings at all times.

We are continuing to have the club professionally sanitized through a fogging machine at a minimum of 2 times per month.

In order for us to comply with mandated (State & Local) policy, I will need all member's cooperation as it applies to reservations and face coverings; Please arrive on time for your reservation and know that in some cases we may have to re-seat your table to allow other members access for dinner and to not exceed our 50% capacity.

Wear face coverings at all time with the exception of when you are seated. Bar seating will be available for cocktails prior to moving to your table, so long as it does not exceed your reservation time. Again access & Capacity. I hope you all know that the staff and I do all these things and will continue to do so for all of our protection & so that we may continue to serve you throughout these unprecedented times.

Member Annual Dues & Minimum amounts are billed automatically according to membership categories:

Resident Dues — \$1100.00 Annually **plus \$1100.00 Food & Beverage Minimum**

Non Resident Dues — \$750.00 Annually **plus \$750.00 Food & Beverage Minimum**

Spouse Privilege Dues — \$550.00 Annually **plus \$550.00 Food & Beverage Minimum**

Guides Dues — \$250.00 Annually **plus \$250.00 Food & Beverage Minimum**

Intermediate {21-35} Dues—\$375.00 Annually **plus \$375.00 Food & Beverage Minimum**

Corporate/Equity- Resident Dues— \$1900.00 **No Food & Beverage Minimum**

Corporate/Non Resident Dues— \$1900.00 **No Food & Beverage Minimum**

If the Food & Beverage minimum is not met upon renewal of your annual dues, the minimum left will be automatically charged to your account. Minimums do not include taxes or service charges.
