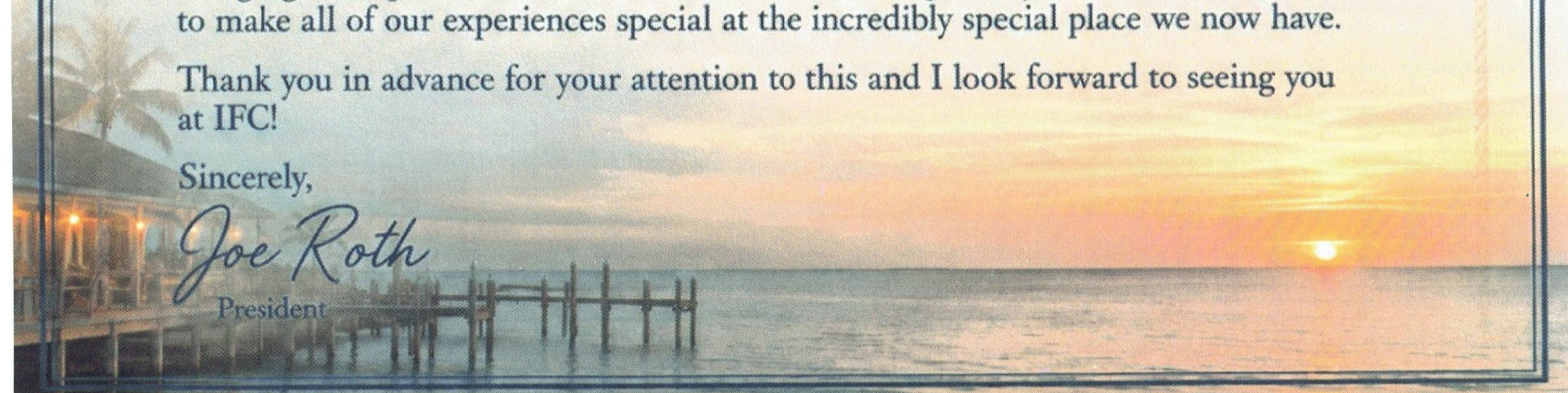
- * All members and guests shall dress in an appropriate manner at all times while on the club premises.

Dear IFC Member,

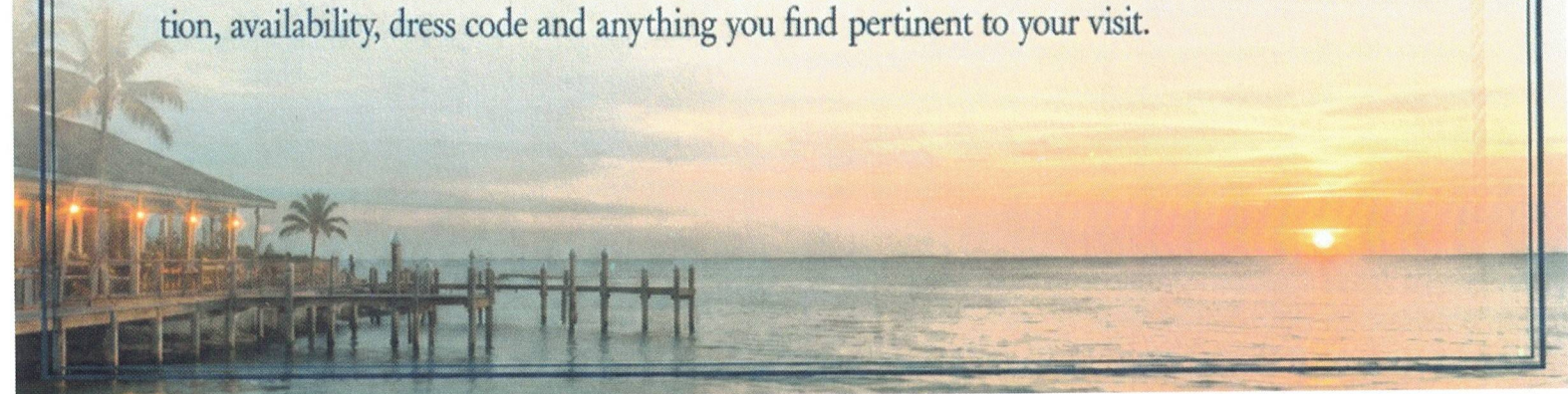

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

Section 10. The board of directors at their discretion may on a case by case basis grant exception to the membership categories as they deem necessary

Effective April 18, 2024

The Board of Directors has unanimously voted to open the Lifetime Membership Category to 25 individuals Who upon Board approval must pay a one-time Dues Assessment of \$30,000.00 plus the current new building assessment of \$15,000.00 for New members. Any current member who has made the final payment for the new Building assessment of no less than \$10,000.00 shall pay a one time Dues assessment of \$30,000.00

Upon application and payment to the club of \$30,000.00 plus any assessments owed, the member shall be entitled to all privileges of the club, including voting and holding office and sharing equally in the equity of the club. If a married couple, one or the other may hold office. Upon the death of any life member, the surviving spouse shall remain as a life member until death or remarriage. This category of membership is eligible for distribution of assets in the event of dissolution and a one (1) time transfer of Membership to an eligible, immediate family member for a transfer fee of \$5,000.00.

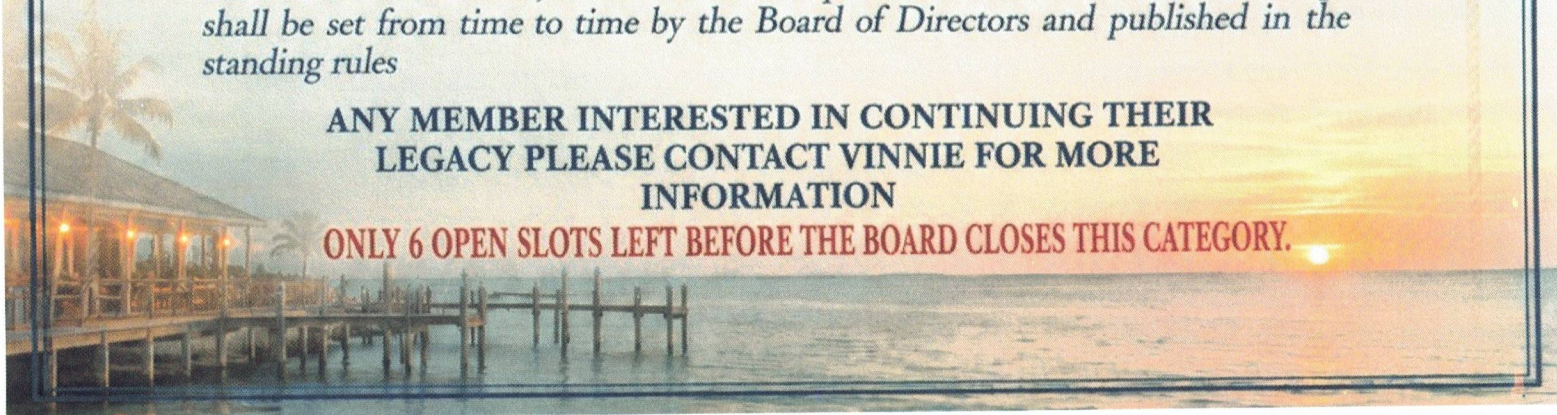
The number of life memberships shall be limited at the discretion of the Board of Directors. Life Members shall not have minimums or dues.

ARTICLE IV ASSESSMENTS

Section 1. Assessments; both annual and special for all classes of memberships shall be set from time to time by the Board of Directors and published in the standing rules

He was a steady voice and a friend to many.



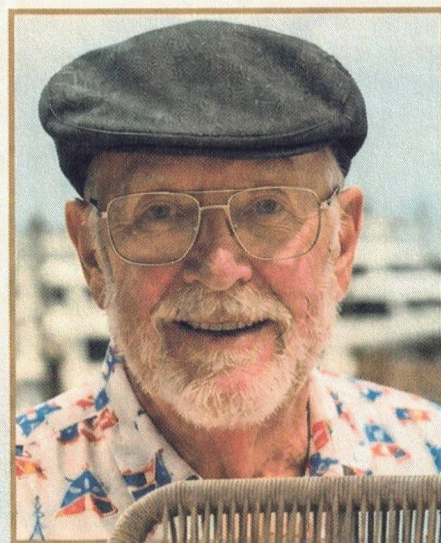
